Discussion Questions

1) What are the theological questions and issues at stake in the Christological controversies? Who are the major players, and what positions do they take on:

- What does the answer to this question mean for a Christian's salvation?
- What is the role of Jesus' mother Mary—who is she, how is she viewed and why is she an issue here?

3) Who was Hypatia? Why was she important in life? What does her death mean for the church in Alexandria?
